## **New photography exhibit at the KU School of Medicine–Wichita**

WICHITA, KAN. – “Two Homelands,” an exhibit by Sam Antonios, MD, will be unveiled at 2:30 p.m., March 2, during a public reception at the KU School of Medicine–Wichita, 1010 N. Kansas.
