WICHITA, KAN. – Volunteers, especially those who speak Spanish, are needed for the fifth annual Give Kids a Smile event from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 10, at GraceMed Clinic, 1122 N. Topeka. Dentists, hygienists, and dental assistants as well as support staff are needed.

The event, sponsored by the Wichita Sedgwick County Oral Health Coalition, provides free dental care to Sedgwick County children ages 3 to 10 who do not have dental insurance. Services include exams, cleanings, fluoride treatments, fillings, and more. The KU School of Medicine–Wichita is part of the Coalition.
